### Group Fees – May 2 - May 28 (4 weeks)

- 1x/week fees below - \$18 lesson (40 minute lessons)
- 2x/week rate is \$16 lesson and office will calculate total fees.
- All classes are priced as Group Lessons *except* Nervous Beginner Semi Privates (NBSP) and Privates. No 'private lessons' in May.
- Group lessons discounts: 10% 1<sup>st</sup>, 15% for 2<sup>nd</sup> or more swimmers.
- \$20 annual registration fee applies for each swimmer.
- Annual fee will be waived for 4S members who enroll in May.
- Swim Test *or observation* is required for placement in group lessons.

**FAQ's Below – Our goal is to continue to update customers via email, website, and in person on the pool deck office (M-F) during our **soft opening** in May. We thank you for your patience in this very exciting journey! [www.robknightswimamerica.com](http://www.robknightswimamerica.com)**

- 1) **Will programming change in the summer?** – A: Yes, as we'll add 2-3 mornings a week so more classes offered.
- 2) **Will classes change days/times in the summer?** – A: Typically we like to keep M-F evening classes mostly the same during the summer, but will evaluate the needs of our customers as we progress.
- 3) **Will you be adding more programming?** – A: Yes, that's the goal. We are starting with four classes running simultaneously, but if we are properly staffed, we should have space in the pool area to expand. We want to start slow during our soft opening in May to try to make the smoothest transition possible.
- 4) **Can I choose my teacher?** – A: No, we staff the group lessons according to the strength of the teacher and their availability. Some teachers excel with younger swimmers, and others are better suited to coach older swimmers. Swim team level instructors often teach in lane 4/5 and could help Rob Knight with Swim Team Prep.
- 5) **Will you offer privates lessons, and can I choose my teacher?** Unfortunately, NOT in May. We need to get all group lessons scheduled, and if you want to swim in May, you'll be placed in a small group class.
- 6) **What is the best way to communicate any questions or concerns during the lessons?** - A: We typically have a deck supervisor (DS) on staff, as teachers do not talk with the parents because of time restraints. The DS is your direct line of communication. We have a full time Lessons Coordinator, Ms. Laura, who will often be on deck, as well as Rob Knight. In terms of registration or payment, email works best *or* stop over to the office area on the pool deck during lessons Monday through Friday evening.
